**COMMITTEE REPORTS**

**Park Committee:**

- FRRPD met on Monday, 12/7/09 to discuss a new offer on Maidu Meadows. The property will be re-appraised prior to either accepting or countering the current counter offer on the property.
- For now, we will use the working title of Berry Creek Interpretive Center (BCIC). The name will be open for discussion at the January meetings.
- There will be a town meeting at the school on Jan. 9th for park input, and a second meeting at the BCIC on Jan. 16th for design review.
- Mary is looking into a possible CEQA exemption for the BCIC.
- Loren is looking into cost estimates for chip sealing Graystone from the beginning to the end of the BCIC.
- Roger is looking into commercial kitchen equipment for the dining hall.
- In January, the Assembly will look at a bill to deed the old Hart's Mill property to FRRPD for use as a Berry Creek History Museum.

**Planning:**

- Mary Keiser talked with Dan Breeden about commercial use designations in Berry Creek. The designations can either be done geographically, or on a case by case basis.
- The current revision of the General Plan does not reflect our request for 5 acre minimums. Roger will bring up the issue with the General Plan committee.

**Public Heath:**

Cathy Jaborski reports good feedback from the county about the shot clinic.

**Roads & Trails:**

Andy Jaborski is going to meet with a rep. from the USFS to discuss cleanup/repair of the Baldrock trailhead.
